

Taking the Skytrain from Vancouver International Airport (YVR) to Vancouver Cancer Centre (VCC)



The Vancouver Airport (YVR), Canada Line Skytrain Station is located above the covered parking garage

Domestic Arrivals (flights arriving from within Canada) – go up to level 3, and then walk towards the International Terminal. Look for the signs that say “Canada Line” and proceed up the escalator (or elevator) to level 4 where there is a covered walkway to the Skytrain Station.

NOTE: When returning to the airport (YVR) take the Canada Line heading towards YVR (not Richmond Brighouse).



Purchasing a ticket

Skytrain ticket machines are located on all Canada Line station platforms. They accept cash, credit and debit/ATM cards. Purchase a 2 Zone ticket from the machine (no transfer is required).

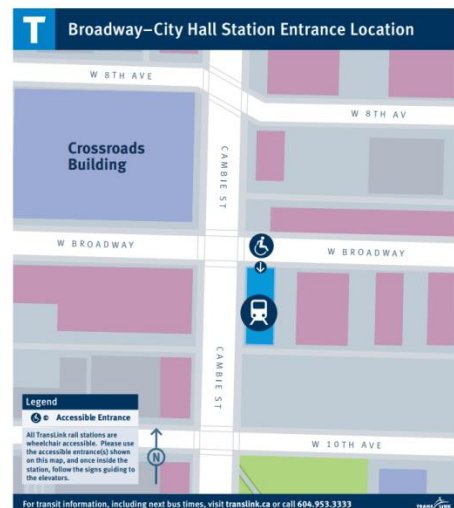
The cost of an adult ticket is \$9.10 this includes \$4.10 (July 1, 2017) for a 2 Zone ticket and \$5.00 add-on charge. The price of a ticket is cheaper for seniors or a child (concession) or if it is after 6:30pm. The ticket is usable for 90 minutes of travel. Retain your ticket to scan or to show transit authorities.

Exiting the Skytrain

Exit the Skytrain at Broadway – City Hall station. It takes about 15-20 minutes traveling on the Skytrain.

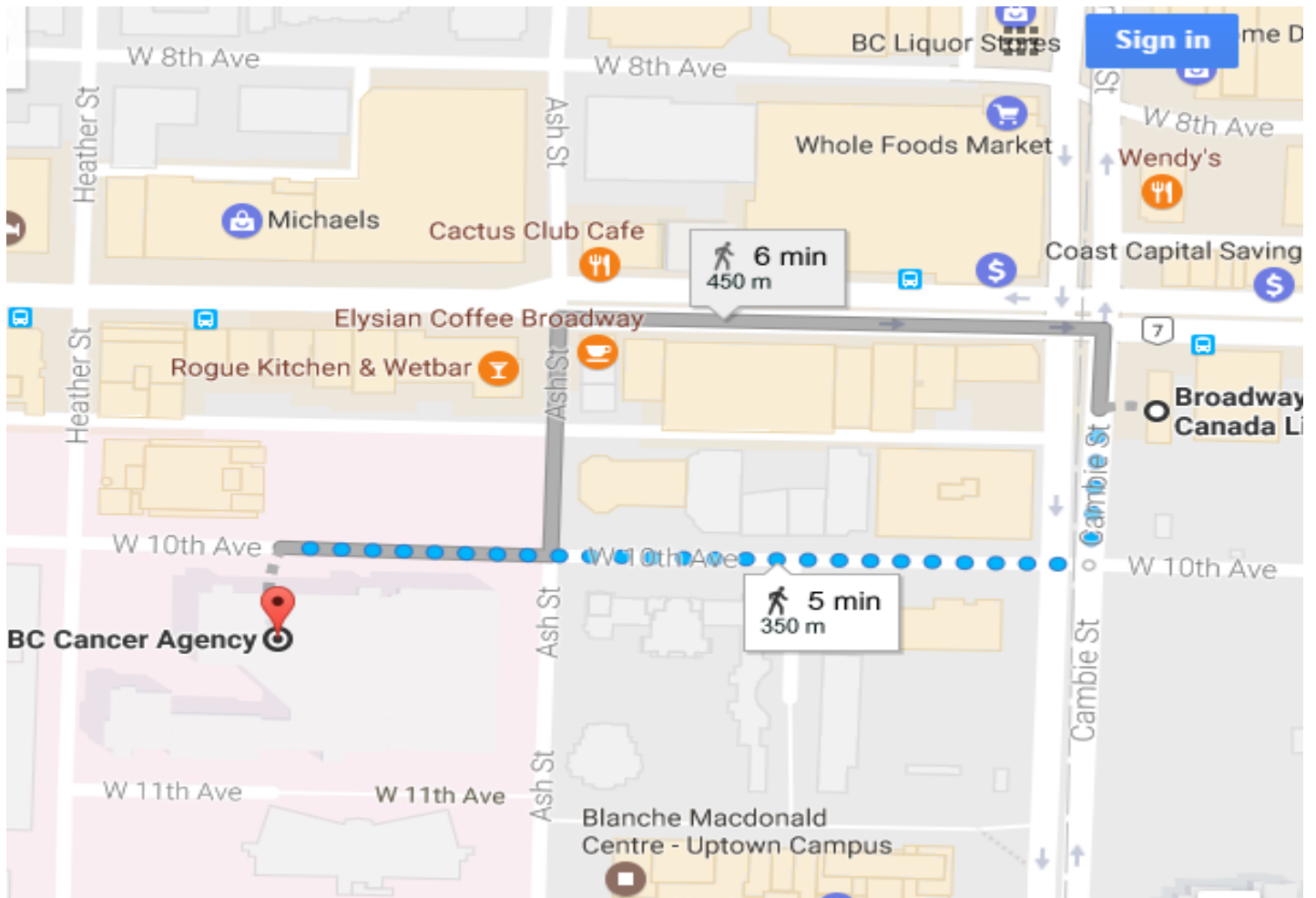
Walking to the Cancer Centre

Walk 1 block west on Broadway, turn left on Ash Street and walk 1 block south. The BC Cancer Agency is on the southeast corner of 10th and Ash - BC Cancer Agency, Vancouver Cancer Centre - 600 West 10th Ave. It is less than a 10 minute walk to walk to VCC from



the Broadway-City Hall Skytrain station.
