Care Transit (Hope, B.C.)

Medical transportation for people with no other options. Must have a physician referral and register. Call 604 869 3396.

Chilliwack Community Services Driver Program
Transportation to attend medical appointments
within the area of Hope to Vancouver. There
is a per/km cost. The average cost from
Chilliwack to Abbotsford is about \$55-60
return trip, not including parking. If the patient's
treatment is more than 3 hours there is an
additional charge for wait time for the driver.

Parking

Abbotsford Regional Hospital & Cancer Centre (ARHCC) Parking Lot & Pass

Pay parking is available in the ARHCC visitor parking lots. Pay at the machine inside the entry doors. You will need your license plate number. Cost is \$2.50 per hour or portion.

BC Cancer patients can use senior's rate for purchasing a weekly or monthly pass at lot #1525.

Peace Lutheran Church Parking Lot
