Introduction

The main objective of the Cancer Drug Manual© (CDM) is to provide a timely, accurate, and unbiased reference source for health care professionals caring for cancer patients. The manual contains concise, evaluative information on oncology drugs recommended for use by the BCCA. Information is presented using a standardized format for consistency and readability.

Documents are written by oncology pharmacists, often with input from clinicians experienced in the use of the particular drug. These documents are then reviewed and approved by a multidisciplinary editorial board of oncology pharmacists, medical oncologists and oncology nurses, to ensure the quality, completeness, and clinical relevance of the information.

The Cancer Drug Manual© is a general drug information resource. For issues of therapeutics, the reader is referred to the BC Cancer Agency's Chemotherapy Protocols, the Cancer Management Guidelines and the most current literature.
