

## **Zanubrutinib Tablets and Capsules – Information for Patients**

#### What is the situation?

Zanubrutinib (BRUKINSA®) is now available in a new **160 mg tablet** formulation.

### What will change for me?

Your zanubrutinib prescription may now be filled with **160 mg tablets** instead of the previous **80 mg capsules**. Both options are available, and your pharmacist will choose the most appropriate one based on your dose.

- Your total daily dose of zanubrutinib remains the same. Your prescription may be updated so you take fewer tablets. For example: one 160 mg tablet will replace the 2 capsules you are currently taking.
- You should expect to have the same results and the same side effects for tablets and capsules.

White, opaque hard gelatin capsules.	Blue, oval tablets with a break line on one side.
Stamped 'ZANU 80'.	Stamped 'Zanu'.
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# Please follow the instructions from your healthcare provider on how to take the new tablets or capsules.

- Zanubrutinib tablets and capsules should be swallowed whole with water, with food or on an empty stomach.
- Zanubrutinib tablets should not be chewed or crushed but can be split. Your pharmacist will tell you when it is okay to split the tablets.
- Avoid grapefruit and grapefruit juice for the duration of your treatment, as these may interact with zanubrutinib.
