

Ribociclib Tablets New Storage in Refrigerator – Information for Patients

What is the situation?

- Ribociclib (Kisqali®) 200mg tablets must now be stored in the refrigerator instead of room temperature.
- There is no change to the look of the tablets or to their packaging.

What will change for me?

• Storage:

- Keep ribociclib tablets refrigerated.
- If you leave your tablets at room temperature, they can be stored for up to 2 months out of the refrigerator.
- Keep tablets in their original packaging to protect from moisture.
- Shipping: If you receive your ribociclib prescription by mail, it will be sent at room temperature. Once you receive your ribociclib prescription, please store tablets in refrigerator.
- **Prescription**: You will continue to receive the same number of ribociclib 200 mg tablets with each prescription.
- **Dosage**: Your total daily dose of ribociclib remains the same.

How should I take my ribociclib tablets?

- Take your tablets in the morning.
- Swallow the tablets whole with water, either with food or on an empty stomach.
- Do not chew or crush the tablets.
- Avoid grapefruit and grapefruit juice during your treatment, as these can interact with your medication.
