How do I change, cancel, or confirm an upcoming appointment?

- Call 604-877-6000, local 673240 to speak with a clerk or leave a message.

What if I'm running late or need to cancel last minute?

• Call 604-877-6000, local 673240 to speak with a clerk or leave a message.

How do I get the results of my recent mammogram or breast MRI?

- If there is anything abnormal that needs follow-up, the clinic NP or physician will contact you directly.
- If the result is normal, you may not receive a phone call.
- We recommend registering with Health Gateway, where you can view your imaging results online.
- Your family doctor also receives a copy of your results and can confirm them for you.

I had a biopsy or extra tests and want to know the results.

- We will contact you once results are received if further follow-up is needed.

I was told to call with the date of my next period for an MRI.

- Call 604-877-6000, local 674896 and leave a message for Imaging at BC Cancer Vancouver.
- If your MRI is at a hospital, call that hospital's imaging department directly.

I'm waiting for an appointment and it is overdue (e.g., MRI, surgery, extra mammogram) or have questions about my care.

I have a new phone number, address, or family doctor.

I have a new health concern (e.g., a breast lump, unusual bleeding).

- Please call 811, or book an appointment with your primary care provider.
 - If you do not currently have a family doctor or nurse practitioner, you can register with the Health Connect Registry, which helps connect patients in B.C. to primary care providers in their community.

I'm ready to be referred to a surgeon.

• Call or email us and we'll connect with you to arrange the referral.

I have questions about risk, lifestyle, or something I read or heard about.

- Email HCPHRC@bccancer.bc.ca to request an appointment with our nurse, Rebecca.
- You can also bring your questions to your next clinic visit.

I need a prescription refill from the High-Risk Clinic.

- If possible, bring your refill request to your next appointment.
- If it's urgent, call 604-877-6000, local 673240 to speak with a clerk or leave a message.

A family member is interested in genetic testing.

• Call 604-877-6000, local 672198 and ask to speak with a genetic counsellor.

Someone in my family has been diagnosed with cancer and I want to update our file.

• Call the Hereditary Cancer Program at 604-877-6000, local 672198.
