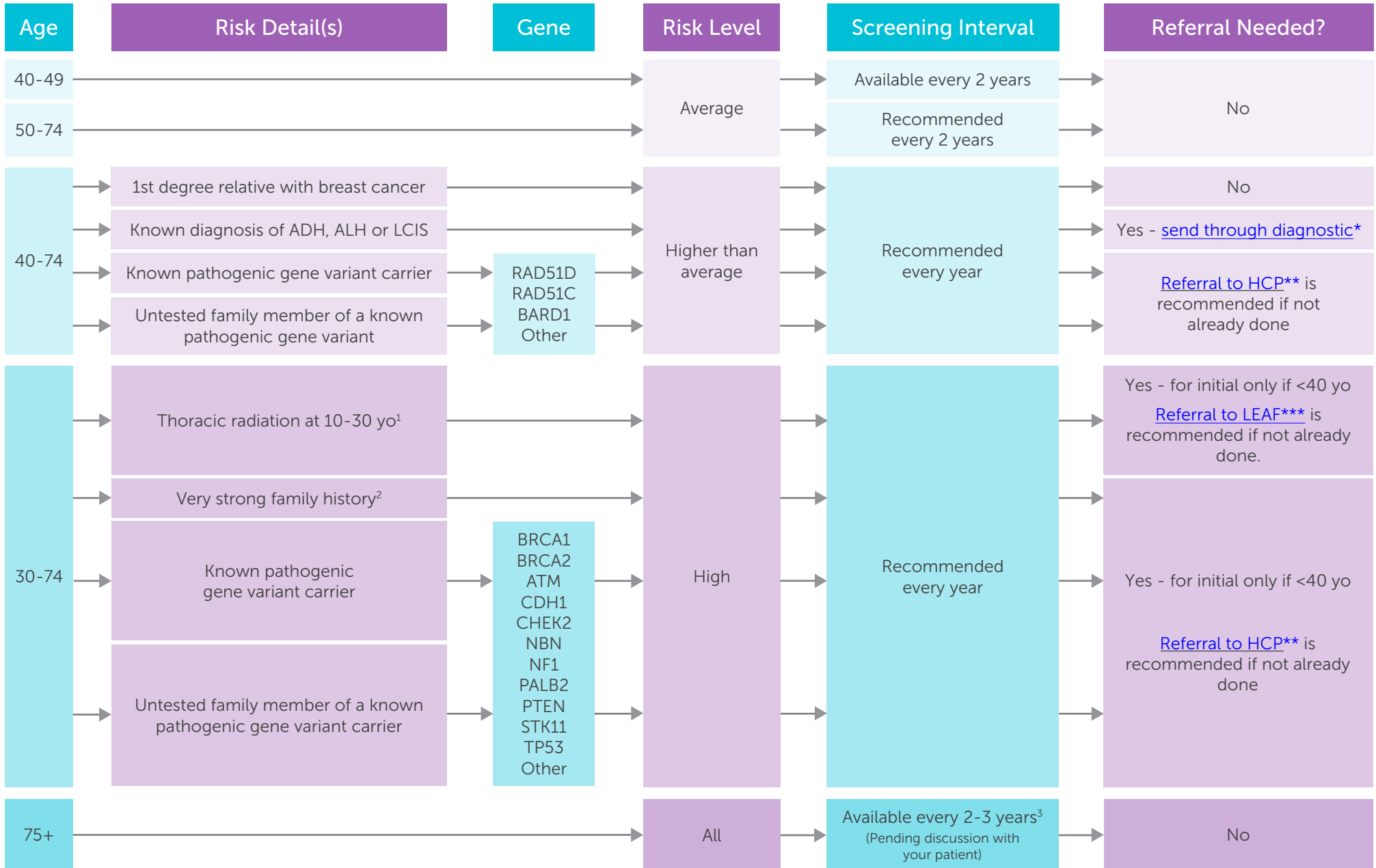


# Breast Screening Referral Algorithm

A decision aid to assist health care providers to appropriately refer and book asymptomatic patients for breast screening.



<sup>1</sup>Typically refers to radiation therapy for pediatric and adolescent cancers.

<sup>2</sup>(A) 2 cases of breast cancer in close female relatives (mother, sister, daughter, aunt, grandmother, or great-aunt) on the same side of the family, both diagnosed before age 50, or (B) 3 or more cases of breast cancer in close female relatives on the same side of the family, with at least one diagnosed before age 50.

<sup>3</sup>Those who are higher or higher than average risk may continue screening annually.
