Results Notification – Normal Result

You are receiving this letter because your primary care provider referred you to the Colon Screening Program.

The result of your recent fecal immunochemical test (FIT) was normal.

NEXT STEPS: No further action is required at this time.

People between the ages of 50 and 74 should be screened for colon cancer every two years, unless otherwise recommended by your primary care provider. In two years, if you are within this age range and registered with a BC address a reminder will be mailed to you when it is time to get checked again.

If you have changed your primary care provider since completing the FIT, or if you have changed your address, please contact the program at 1-877-702-6566 so we can update your information.

In addition to doing a FIT every two years, you should look out for any unusual changes to your body. Check for any blood in your stool, abdominal pain, change in bowel habits, anemia, or unexplained weight loss. If you notice anything unusual, talk to your primary care provider.
