#### 7 Additional Testing

You may be asked to return for additional testing to look more closely at a specific area. This does not mean you have cancer.

## If you have a first degree relative (parent, child or full sibling) with a history of breast cancer,

come back in 1 year.

Otherwise, come back in 2 years.

### **Regular Screening**

We'll send you a reminder when it's time to return for your next screening mammogram. Research has shown a 25% reduction in deaths from breast cancer among those who have regular screening mammograms.
