


# WHAT HAPPENS AFTER YOUR SCREENING MAMMOGRAM?

## 1 Results

Your results will be mailed to you and the health care provider within 3 weeks. You may also access your results online through Health Gateway ([healthgateway.gov.bc.ca](http://healthgateway.gov.bc.ca)).



## 2 Additional Testing

You may be asked to return for additional testing to look more closely at a specific area. This does not mean you have cancer.

## 3 Regular Screening

We'll send you a reminder when it's time to return for your next screening mammogram. Research has shown a 25% reduction in deaths from breast cancer among those who have regular screening mammograms.

\* If you have a first degree relative (parent, child or full sibling) with a history of breast cancer, come back in **1 year**.

Otherwise, come back in **2 years**.
