



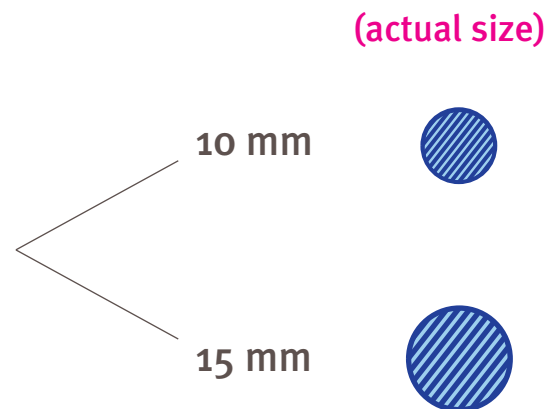

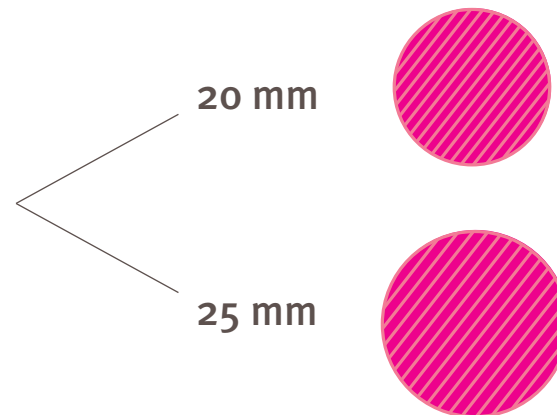

Why Mammograms Work

Most lumps found by regular screening mammograms are relatively small - between **10 mm** and **15 mm** in diameter.



Most lumps found by breast self-examination are relatively larger - between **20 mm** and **25 mm** in diameter.
