Practice physical distancing:

Please keep a distance of at least 2 metres from others. Screening centres will be rearranging their waiting areas and allowing more time between patients to support physical distancing.



Wear a mask:

If you have a face mask (surgical or home-made), you can wear it to your appointment. Your technologist will be wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) to protect themselves and others.



Help us stay germ free:

Use available hand sanitizer and/or hand-washing stations to support good hand hygiene. Mammography equipment and exam rooms will be frequently cleaned and sanitized.
