British Columbia and Yukon Cancer Registry Reporting Guidelines for Laboratories

ALL PATHOLOGY, CYTOLOGY, LABORATORY, BONE MARROW AND TUMOUR MARKER REPORTS THAT SHOW ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Tumours -- malignant, pre-malignant or of uncertain behaviour including any descriptors ending in 'oma'.
- Systemic malignant and pre-malignant diseases – leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease, myeloma and other myeloproliferative and lymphoproliferative disorders.
- Carcinoma in-situ, intraepithelial high grade or grade III, non-infiltrating or non-invasive.
- Benign tumours of the meninges, brain, spinal cord, cranial nerves and other parts of the central nervous system, pituitary, craniopharyngeal duct and pineal gland.
- Reports with ambiguous terms such as "Appears", "Compatible With", "Consistent With", "Favours", "Most Likely", "Presumed", "Probable", "Suspicious", "Typical".
