General Summary

In 2019, an estimated 2480 British Columbians will be newly diagnosed with another type of cancer that is not reported separately in the cancer statistics.

One in 21 females and one in 20 males is expected to develop another type of cancer that is not reported separately in the cancer statistics.

One in 39 females and one in 35 males is expected to die of another type of cancer that is not reported separately in the cancer statistics.
