

Statistics by Cancer Type - Bladder

General Summary

In 2019, an estimated 1735 British Columbians will be newly diagnosed with bladder cancer and 345 will die of it. An estimated 89% of those diagnosed with bladder cancer will be over the age of 60 when they are diagnosed. An estimated 78% of those diagnosed with bladder cancer will be men.

One in 65 females and one in 20 males is expected to develop bladder cancer during their lifetime.

One in 225 females and one in 76 males is expected to die of bladder cancer.
