Statistics by Cancer Type - Kidney

General Summary

In 2017, an estimated 680 British Columbians will be newly diagnosed with kidney cancer and 230 will die of it. Almost 66% of those diagnosed with kidney cancer will be male.

One in 111 females and one in 56 males is expected to develop kidney cancer during their lifetime.

One in 299 females and one in 148 males is expected to die of kidney cancer.
