

Statistics by Cancer Type - Melanoma (Skin)

General Summary

In 2021, an estimated 1345 British Columbians will be newly diagnosed with melanoma. One in 52 females and one in 40 males is expected to develop melanoma during their lifetime. One in 445 females and one in 253 males is expected to die of melanoma.
