

## Statistics by Cancer Type - Non-Hodgkin Lymphoma

### General Summary

In 2018, an estimated 1245 British Columbians will be newly diagnosed with Non-Hodgkin lymphoma and 365 will die of it. One in 44 females and one in 36 males is expected to develop Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma during their lifetime. One in 119 females and one in 89 males is expected to die of Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma.
