#### REVISED PROCESS FOR UNDESIGNATED INDICATION APPROVAL

Please note that all undesignated drug applications should now be faxed to Dr. Suzanne Taylor at (604) 877-6132, who will triage all requests in collaboration with the BC Cancer Agency Tumour Group designate and the Systemic Therapy Program Leader or designates. For more details, please refer to the letter attached. A revised "Undesignated Indication" approval form can be obtained via Hdrive at regional cancer centres, our website, or Fax-back as listed at the end of the Update.

#### PROTOCOL UPDATE

**Protocols by Drugs Index** A cross-referenced index lists the BC Cancer Agency benefit drugs with their corresponding protocols. This index can be obtained via H-drive at regional cancer centres or Fax-back as listed at the end of the Update.

Protocol codes for treatments requiring "Undesignated Indication" approval prior to use are prefixed with the letter **U**.

- INDEX to BC Cancer Agency Protocol Summaries revised monthly (includes tumour group, protocol code, indication, drugs, last revision date and version)
- UBRAVTR revised (process for adding BCCA benefit drugs clarified): Palliative therapy for metastatic breast cancer using trastuzumab (Herceptin®)
- BRAVTRNAV revised (duration of treatment and process for continuing single agent trastuzumab clarified): Palliative therapy for metastatic breast cancer using trastuzumab (Herceptin®) and vinorelbine
- **CNIME** revised (typos corrected in Dose Modifications): Ifosfamide, mesna and etoposide in the treatment of recurrent brain tumours
- **ENAVD** new (formalised): Palliative therapy for advanced endocrine cancers using doxorubicin
- **GIIRFUFA** revised (dose modifications): Firstline palliative combination chemotherapy for metastatic colorectal cancer using irinotecan, fluorouracil and folinic acid (leucovorin)
- **GUSCARB** revised (eligibility): Adjuvant therapy for stage I high risk seminoma using carboplatin
- LUDOC revised (eligibility): Second-line treatment for advanced non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC) with docetaxel (Taxotere<sup>®</sup>)

#### PRE-PRINTED ORDER UPDATE

Pre-printed orders should always be checked with the most current BC Cancer Agency protocol summaries. The Vancouver Cancer Centre has prepared the following chemotherapy pre-printed orders, which can be used as a guide for reference:

- **GIA** revised (premed dexamethasone dose): Palliative therapy for hepatoma using doxorubicin
- **GIEFUP** revised (premed dexamethasone dose): Combined modality therapy for locally advanced esophageal cancer using fluorouracil and cisplatin
- **GIENDO2** revised (premed dexamethasone dose): Palliative therapy for pancreatic endocrine tumours using streptozocin and doxorubicin
- **GIIR** revised (premed dexamethasone dose): Second-line palliative treatment for fluorouracil-refractory metastatic colorectal cancer using irinotecan
- **GIIRFUFA** revised: First-line palliative combination chemotherapy for metastatic colorectal cancer using irinotecan, fluorouracil and folinic acid (leucovorin)
- **GOOVTOP** revised: Treatment of relapsed/progressive epithelial ovarian, fallopian tube or primary peritoneal cancer using topotecan
- **GUSCARB** new: Adjuvant therapy for stage I high risk seminoma using carboplatin
- **LYCYCLO** new: Therapy of lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease, chronic lymphocytic leukemia or multiple myeloma using cyclophosphamide

#### **PATIENT EDUCATION**

**Breast Cancer** The patient information section for breast cancer on the BC Cancer Agency website has been revised and is available on BC Cancer Agency website www.bccancer.bc.ca/cid.

#### **DRUG UPDATE**

**Cytarabine** Preparation and stability for cytarabine syringes have been standardised in the regional cancer centres of the BC Cancer Agency. Cytarabine 100 mg powder vial is to be reconstituted with 1 mL bacteriostatic water for injection. The reconstituted solution and syringe are stable for 15 days at room temperature.

**Pamidronate** Effective 10 September, the BCHS contract for pamidronate has been awarded to Faulding. Please ensure that your pharmacy purchaser is aware of this when current supplies have run out.

**Trastuzumab** Please note that the UBRAVTR protocol requires that trastuzumab be stopped in patients whose systemic disease progresses. The paclitaxel-trastuzumab regimen (BRAVTRAP) should be used prior to UBRAVTR. The vinorelbine-trastuzumab regimen (BRAVTRNAV) is reserved for patients who are ineligible for BRAVTRAP.
