# PROTOCOL UPDATE

**Protocols by Drugs Index** A cross-referenced index lists the BC Cancer Agency benefit drugs with their corresponding protocols. This index can be obtained via H-drive at regional cancer centres or Fax-back as listed at the end of the Update.

Protocol codes for treatments requiring "Undesignated Indication" approval prior to use are prefixed with the letter **U**.

 INDEX to BC Cancer Agency Protocol Summaries revised monthly (includes tumour group, protocol code, indication, drugs, last revision date and version). These revisions will be effective 1 February, 2002.

- **GUBEP** revised (etoposide and cisplatin infusion time): Bleomycin, etoposide, cisplatin for nonseminoma germ cell cancers
- GUEP revised (etoposide infusion time): Etoposide-cisplatin protocol for germ cell cancers
- LYCHOP-R revised (eligibility and rituximab scheduling): Treatment of lymphoma with doxorubicin, cyclophosphamide, vincristine, prednisone and rituximab
- LYFLU revised (hepatitis B warning):
   Treatment of low grade lymphoma or chronic lymphocytic leukemia with fludarabine

### PRE-PRINTED ORDER UPDATE

Pre-printed orders should always be checked with the most current BC Cancer Agency protocol summaries. The Vancouver Cancer Centre has prepared the following chemotherapy pre-printed orders, which can be used as a guide for reference:

- BRAVDOC revised (Indication for use clarified to be consistent with protocol):
   Palliative therapy for metastatic breast cancer using docetaxel (Taxotere<sup>®</sup>)
- GIFFAD revised (premeds, appointments):
   Adjuvant therapy for stage III and high risk stage II colon cancer using leucovorin and fluorouracil
- GIRALT revised (premeds, appointments):
   Palliative therapy for unresectable or metastatic colorectal cancer using raltitrexed (Tomudex®)

An index to the orders can be obtained by Fax-back.

#### DRUG UPDATE

**Docetaxel** A new formulation of docetaxel (Taxotere®) is now available and differs from the previous formulation in the following:

- 1. Stability of concentrate for injection: unopened vials are stable at room temperature and shipped non-refrigerated.
- 2. Mixing instruction: premix solution is to gently rotated for 45 seconds.
- 3. Stability of infusion solution: diluted solution is stable for 4 hours.

For more details, please refer to the letter sent by Aventis in December 2001 (Taxotere®: new storage and handling conditions).

**Mitoxantrone** Until further notice, all CON pharmacies should bill BC Cancer Agency for full vials of the Faulding mitoxantrone 20 mg product to recover the cost of any amounts of medication wasted. For example, if 22 mg is dispensed, CON pharmacies will be reimbursed for two 20 mg vials.

**Zoledronic acid** is a new biphosphonate currently licensed for the treatment of malignancy-related hypercalcemia. It is not a BC Cancer Agency benefit drug. For more details on the use of zoledronic acid in the treatment of hypercalcemia, please refer to the BCCA protocol SCHYPCAL.
