PROTOCOL UPDATE

Protocol codes for treatments requiring "Undesignated Indication" approval prior to use are prefixed with the letter \mathbf{U} .

- INDEX to BCCA Protocol Summaries revised monthly (includes tumour group, protocol code, indication, drugs, last revision date and version)
- BRAJCEF revised (tests clarified, treatment strategies following a second febrile event and references added): Adjuvant therapy for breast cancer using cyclophosphamide, epirubicin and fluorouracil
- **KSAD** reformatted: Palliative therapy for Kaposi's sarcoma using doxorubicin
- LYABVD revised (LDH deleted and creatinine added to baseline tests, dilution volume for dacarbazine revised): Treatment of Hodgkin's disease with doxorubicin, bleomycin, vinblastine, and dacarbazine

PRE-PRINTED ORDER UPDATE

Vancouver Cancer Centre has prepared the following chemotherapy pre-printed orders, which can be used as a guide:

Oncology reference:

 GIRALT: Palliative treatment of symptomatic advanced or metastatic colorectal cancer using raltitrexed in patients with previous fluorouracil toxicity

- LUALTE (pre-printed orders titled LUALTE-EP and LUALTE-CAV): Alternating CAV/EP for extensive stage small cell lung cancer
- LUALTL (pre-printed orders titled LUALTL-CAV and LUALTL-EP): Limited stage small cell lung cancer alternating cyclophosphamide, doxorubicin and vincristine with etoposide and cisplatin plus early thoracic irradiation
- LUCAV: Extensive small cell lung cancer with cyclophosphamide, doxorubicin and vincristine
- SADITC: High dose single agent dacarbazine for metastatic soft tissue sarcoma
- SMDD revised (dilution volume changed to 250-500 mL): Palliative therapy for metastatic malignant melanoma using cisplatin and dacarbazine
- SMDTIC revised (dilution volume changed to 250-500 mL): Palliative therapy for metastatic malignant melanoma using high dose dacarbazine

DRUG UPDATE

Cisapride (Prepulsid®) is a prokinetic agent used in the supportive care of cancer patients. Other alternative prokinetic agents include metoclopramide and domperidone. Since its launch in early nineties cisapride has been associated with more than 292 cases of serious cardiac arrhythmias (including 76 deaths) in the US and Canada. Most cases involved concurrent use of drugs which cause OT prolongation or inhibit hepatic metabolism of cisapride, depleted serum electrolytes (potassium, calcium, magnesium), or comorbid conditions which predispose patients to arrhythmias. As a result, cisapride has been removed from the US market since March 2000. Currently, cisapride is commercially available in Canada. Health Canada's Therapeutic Products Program is presently evaluating the new data and the manufacturer has sent out a letter to health care professionals in February 2000 with revised prescribing, safety and precautions information.
