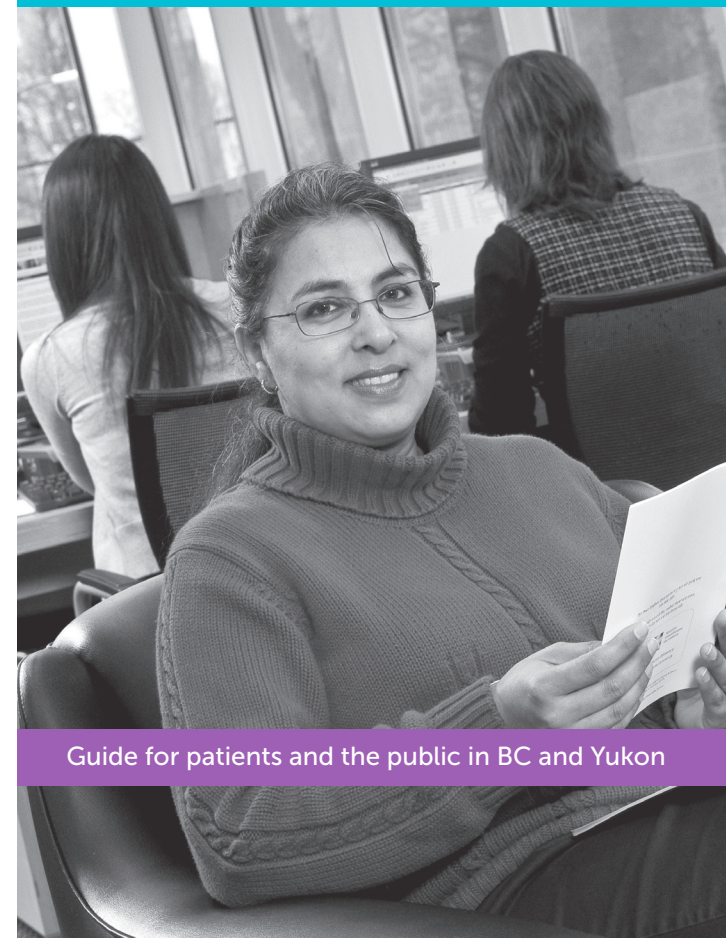

Request

1. Search the catalogue. *Only items listed as Patient or Public may be requested.*
2. Use the **Add to List** button to select what you want.
3. At the top of the screen, click on **My List > View List > Borrow**
4. Fill out the contact form. Library staff will contact you if we have any questions.
5. Don't forget to click the **Confirm** button and watch for an email confirmation.
6. Pick your order up from the nearest Cancer Information Centre.

If you don't live near a BC Cancer centre, we'll mail anywhere in BC and Yukon for **free**. We'll even include the return postage!
