Your lung screening CT scan shows no concerning findings for lung cancer. However, we have shared other findings with the health care provider that are **not** related to lung cancer and may require follow-up. These could include conditions such as Emphysema, COPD, and/or Coronary Artery Calcification, that you may already be aware of.

**NEXT STEPS:** Detailed results of your CT scan have been sent to the health care provider on record: BETTY PLISBVDB in case you have questions about the follow-up. If you do not hear from them within one week of receiving this letter, please contact them directly to make an appointment.

We recommend you return to the Lung Screening Program in **24** months for routine screening. You will receive a reminder letter from the Lung Screening Program when it is time to return for your next CT scan. Screening works best when you receive regular CT scans to see if there are any new spots or changes to existing spots since your last scan. This is why it's important to return for lung screening when you're due.

Although a lung screening CT scan is very effective at finding lung cancer early, some cancers may be missed. If you develop any new symptoms such as shortness of breath, chest pain, or coughing up blood, please inform the health care provider right away, even if you have had a normal CT scan.

**SMOKING CESSATION:** At time of intake, you informed the Program that you were smoking or had recently quit. Stopping smoking doubles the benefits of lung screening and significantly improves your lung health. Please see the enclosed brochure for information and resources on smoking cessation. Studies have found that prescription drugs such as Varenicline can improve your chances of quitting. We recommend you reach out to the health care provider to discuss smoking cessation prescription drugs that may be covered by the BC Smoking Cessation Program.
