Your lung screening CT scan shows you to have a low chance of lung cancer.

**NEXT STEPS:** Return for routine screening in **12** months. We would like to keep an eye on the health of your lungs as the risk of lung cancer changes with age. You will receive a reminder letter from the Program when it is time to return for your next CT scan. Screening works best when you receive regular CT scans to see if there are any new spots or changes to existing spots since your last scan. This is why it's important to return for lung screening when you're due.

Although a lung screening CT scan is very effective at finding lung cancer early, some cancers may be missed. If you develop any new symptoms such as shortness of breath, chest pain, or coughing up blood, please inform a health care provider right away, even if you have had a normal CT scan.
